SENTENCES totalling 18 months and a ten-year driving ban were imposed by Judge James McNulty at Kinsale Court on a motorist who was found either driving or drunk in charge of a car in West Cork on four occasions.

Arkadiusz Koval, Curraheen Lislevane, and formerly wife addresses in Weir Street a O'Mahony Avenue, Bandon pleaded guilty, through solicitor Mr. Plunkett Taaffe, and was sentenced to: concurrent for month prison terms with a ten years disqualification for driving with excess alcohol and insurance at Capp Enniskeane, on October 2007; concurrent four-month prison terms with a ten year driving ban for being drunk in charge of a vehicle and insurance at Bandon on May 12, 2008; concurrent five months sentences with a ten year disqualification for being drunk in charge and no insurance at Danganmore, Bandon on April 5; nine months' jail for being drunk in charge and concurrent sentence of five months for no insurance with ten years driving ban in respect of Ballincurmo, Courtmacsherry, on May 31; nine month imprisonment for escaping from custody while detained at Bandon Garda Station on May 1 and four months' jail, suspended on condition defendant do not drive while disqualified, the summons for driving which disqualified on May 31.

Other minor traffic offences were marked taken into consideration and the Judge directed that the three of the conviction for run consecutively, making total of 18 months' imprisonment.
